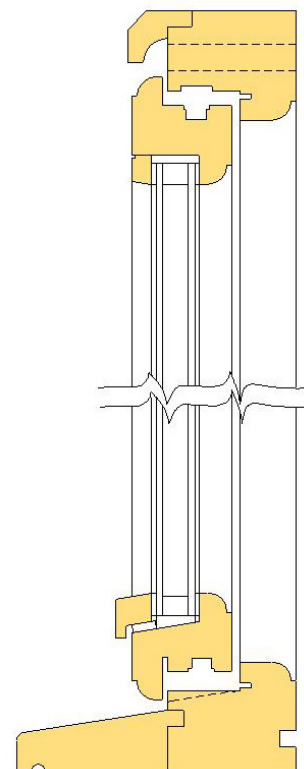
At North West Timber Products we have invested in machinery and tooling to enable us to produce timber windows in line with all the latest regulations and performance criteria.

Our windows are supplied in Scandinavian Fifth Redwood or in the Hardwood of your choice. Softwood windows are always pressure treated with Organic Solvent before priming whereas the hardwood windows receive a suitable basecoat (Impra) before delivery. Should you require factory finished windows we would be happy to oblige.

We do not offer a catalogue of standard sizes and patterns, we prefer to manufacture what our customers want to the sizes they require.

Windows can be supplied with or without glass; all opening lights are fully weather stripped and all double glazed units are located on a sloping bottom rail to allow for the best practice, drained and vented glazing system.

Glazing Options

Clear, Opaque, Textured, Toughened, Laminated

We always recommend Pilkingtons Low E Glass, 24mm Double glazed units (4,16,4) which give a high level of thermal insulation in line with Document L.

Available as clear, obscure, toughened or laminated.

When we are supplying ready glazed windows we always install our units using best practice drained and vented glazing methods.

Typically we use Hodgson's Sealants Flexi-strip or Flexi-bond depending upon the

degree of security required.

If we are not glazing we are happy to recommend or to supply the glazing strip along with the correct flat and angled packers required for correct installation.

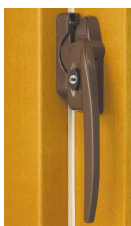

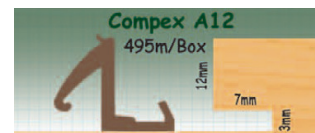
